Program Itinerary

Beijing, Xi'an, Guilin and Shanghai

Day 1 SFO / BEIJING

Depart from San Francisco by **Air China or United Airline's** jetliner to Beijing. Cross the International Date Line and lose one day.

Day 2 ARRIVE BEIJING

Arrive in Beijing, the capital city of China, and transfer to the **five-star** Wanda Realm Beijing Hotel or similar.

Day 3 BEIJING (AB, L, D)

Today's sightseeing includes Tiananmen Square, the Forbidden City where the emperors of the Ming Qing Dynasties ruled China, and also a visit to the Beijing Zoo. After lunch, visit the Olympic Venue of "Bird's Nest" stadium. Performance will be arranged with a local high school performing team in the performing center. There will be time for social exchange between the students.

Day 4 BEIJING (AB, L, D)

In the morning, take a coach to the Great Wall, a symbol of China and a fantastic sight that can never be omitted. Your group will do a **brief performance at the Great Wall entrance plaza** and a special group picture will be taken at the Great Wall. Afterwards, a visit to the Jade Factory. In the afternoon, visit the beautiful Summer Palace, the traditional emperors' summer residence. Enjoy a **Beijing Duck Banquet** in the evening.

Day 5 BEIJING / XI'AN (AB, L, D)

Take morning flight to Xi'an, once China's capital and an important city on the silk road. Transfer to the **five-star** Grand Noble Hotel or similar. After lunch, visit the Art and Handicraft Factory and the ancient city wall. A Welcome Dumpling Banquet hosted by the Tourism Administration of the city government and other local officials followed by Tang Dynasty Culture Show at night will be the highlight of the evening.

Day 6 XI'AN (AB, L, D)

A full day of sightseeing features one of the tour highlights, the army of the Terra Cotta Warriors, created 2,200 years ago to protect Emperor Qin Shi Huang in his afterlife; After lunch, transfer back to the hotel and rehearse in the hotel lobby. An **Evening performance will be arranged at the local high school or university performing Art Center, sharing stage with Chinese student performing teams**.

Day 7 X I'AN / GUILIN (AB, L, D)

In the morning, visit the majestic Wild Goose Pagoda. After lunch, take a late afternoon flight to the mystical city of Guilin. Check into the **five-star** <u>Lijiang Waterfall Hotel</u> or similar.

Day 8 GUILIN (AB, L, D)

Spend the day aboard a scenic Li River cruise, passing picturesque farms and fishing villages with thousands of limestone outcroppings, Guilin has been the inspiration for generations of silk scroll painters. In the late afternoon, a Welcome Banquet will be hosted by the Mayor of the city government and other local officials. You will have an evening performance with Chinese student performing teams at the famous city square (with special permit issued by the city government) or at the hotel performing center, which can hold up to 2,000 people. Social exchange between the students will be arranged after the performance.

Day 9 GUILIN / SHANGHAI (AB,L,D)

Visit the Reed Flute Caves and Pearl Factory in the morning. After lunch, visit the Elephant Trunk Hill. Take an afternoon flight to Shanghai. Upon your arrival, you will be transferred to the **five-star** <u>Wyndham Bund East Shanghai Hotel</u> or similar.

Day 10 SHANGHAI (AB, L, D)

Shanghai is a unique city, which was once a European concession, blending western architecture, oriental culture and bustling economic life together. Today's city tour encompasses the Yu Garden, carpet factory and the world-renowned Bund on the city's waterfront, which was the international area developed during the colonial era. In the afternoon, you will have some free time at Nan Jing Road shopping area. **Or a Joint Exchange Performance can be arranged with the local school.** The bus will pick you up and take you to dinner. **Enjoy an Acrobatic Show** at night after dinner.

Day 11 SHANGHAI / SFO (AB)

Fly home on board Air China or United Airlines' jetliner
