Program Itinerary

Beijing, Shijiazhuang Xi'an and Shanghai

Day 1 SFO / BEIJING

Depart from San Francisco by Air China or United Airline's jetliner for Beijing. Cross the International Date Line and lose a day.

Day 2 ARRIVE BEIJING

Arrive in Beijing, the capital of China, and transfer to the **five-star** <u>Wanda Realm Beijing Hotel</u> or similar.

Day 3 BEIJING (AB, L, D)

Today's sightseeing includes Tiananmen Square, the Forbidden City where the emperors of Ming and Qing Dynasty ruled China and also a visit to the Beijing Zoo. After lunch, visit the Olympic Venue of "**Bird's Nest**" stadium. A **Performance will be arranged with a local high school performing team in the**

performing center. There will be time for social exchange between the students.

Day 4 BEIJING (AB, L, D)

In the morning, take a coach to the Great Wall, a symbol of China and a fantastic sight that can never be omitted. The band will have a **brief performance in uniform at the Great Wall entrance plaza** and a special group picture will be taken at the Great Wall. In the afternoon, visit the beautiful Summer Palace, the traditional emperors' summer residence. Enjoy a **Beijing Duck Banquet** in the evening.

Day 5 BEIJING/SHIJIAZHUANG (AB, L, D)

Visit the Temple of Heaven, where the emperors offered sacrifices to heaven and prayed for good harvest. In the afternoon, transfer to the city of Shijiazhuang by deluxe coach. Check into the new five-star <u>Hebei Century Hotel</u> or similar. In the evening a Welcome Banquet will be hosted by the Tourism Administration of the Provincial Government of Hebei and other Provincial leaders.

Day 6 SHIJIAZHUANG (AB, L, D)

City tour today includes Longxing Monastery in the morning. After lunch, a marching performance with Shijiazhuang No.1 High School students in the school campus will be arranged. In the evening, the band performs a concert at the performing center sharing the program with Chinese musicians.

Day 7 SHIJIAZHUANG / BEIJING / XI'AN (AB, L, D)

In the morning, depart for Beijing by deluxe coach. After lunch, direct transfer to the airport for flight to Xi'an, once China's capital and an important city on the silk road. Transfer to the **five-star** <u>Grand Noble Hotel</u> or similar. A Welcome Dumpling Banquet hosted by the Tourism administration of the city government and other local officials followed by the Tang Dynasty Culture Show will be the highlight of the evening.

Day 8 XI'AN (AB, L, D)

A full day of sightseeing features one of today's tour highlights, the army of the Terra Cotta Warriors, created 2,200 years ago to protect Emperor Qin Shi Huang in the afterlife. After lunch, visit the Big Wild Goose Pagoda. A performance will be arranged at a local high school or university sharing the stage with Chinese performers.

Day 9 XI'AN / SHANGHAI (AB, L, D)

Morning flight to Shanghai. Upon arrival, transfer to the **five-star** <u>Wyndham Bund East</u> <u>Shanghai Hotel</u> or similar. Visit the Bund,

the fascinating waterfront thoroughfare, full of magnificent skyscrapers. Enjoy an Acrobatic Show at night.

Day 10 SHANGHAI (AB, L, D)

Shanghai is a unique city, which was once a European concession, blending western architecture, oriental culture and bustling economic life together. Today's city tour encompasses the Yu Garden, carpet factory and the Pudong Development Zone on the other side of Huangpu River. In the afternoon, you will have free time at the Nan Jing Road shopping area for your shopping or sightseeing on your own. Or you can choose a joint exchange performance to be arranged with a local school. The bus will pick you up and take you to dinner.

Day 11 SHANGHAI / SFO (AB)

Fly home on board Air China or United Airline's jetliner.
