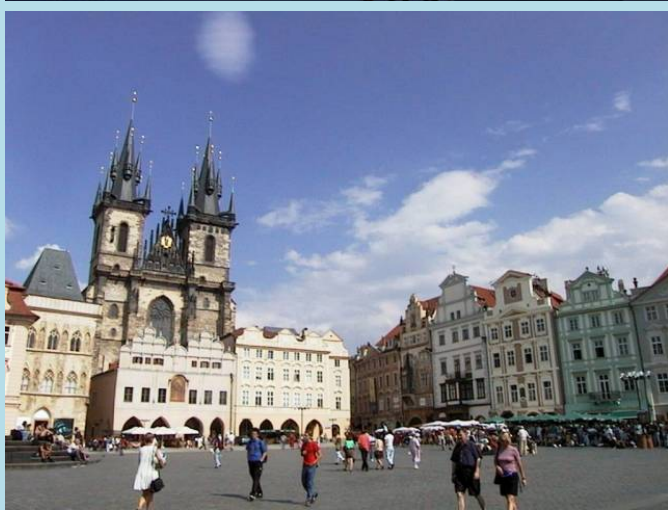

### Day 1

### Flight

Overnight flight to Berlin. Meals on plane.

### Day 2

### Berlin

Willkommen in Berlin (welcome in Berlin). *Berlin is a world city of culture, politics, media and science. It is home to renowned universities, research institutes, sporting events, orchestras, museums and personalities. The urban and historical legacy had made it also a popular setting for international film productions.*

Upon arrival meet your tour escort and bus driver and transfer to the city centre for a **guided tour of former East Berlin**. You will see the famous avenue Unter den Linden, the Opera building and you will **visit the Pergamon Museum**, one of the most unique museums of the world. Admire the Pergamon Altar part of the Zeus Temple from a town that is now Turkey dating from 160-180 B.C.

Check into your hotel afterwards. Dinner and overnight in Berlin.

### Day 3

### Berlin

In the morning travel to Potsdam (approx. 1 hour from Berlin), where you will **visit the Palace Sanssouci** which used to be the country-residence of Frederic the Great or the Neues Palais. **Possible performance** at Sanssouci Castle in Potsdam. *Other performance possibilities are the Domkirche or Gedächtniskirche in Berlin.*

In the afternoon travel back to Berlin and have the rest of the afternoon at leisure. Dinner and overnight in Berlin.

### Day 4

### Berlin

After breakfast this morning **visit of Jewish Museum** is planned. Two millennia of German Jewish history let the visitor see the past and present through the eyes of the Jewish minority.

Have the rest of the day at leisure for individual sightseeing or shopping. Dinner and overnight in Berlin.

## Day 5

## Berlin – Prague

This morning after breakfast check out of the hotel and travel to Prague. Possible stop in Dresden along the way.

*Prague is one of the most enchanting cities of Europe. It was under Charles IV during the 14<sup>th</sup> century that Prague briefly became the seat of the Holy Roman Empire – virtually the capital of Western Europe – and acquired its distinctive Gothic imprint. Prague escaped serious wartime damage and is considered one of the most beautiful cities in Europe today. Mozart claimed that no one understood him better than the citizens of Prague, and he was only one of several great masters who lived or lingered here.*

Upon arrival small orientation tour with your tour escort before checking into your hotel. Dinner and overnight in Prague.

## Day 6

## Prague

This morning have a **guided walking tour** of Prague which covers the Castle district, including a visit to **St. Vitus Cathedral, St. George Basilica & the old Royal Palace**.

In the afternoon **possible performance** for example at St. Nicholas Church at the Old Town Square. Dinner and overnight in Prague.

## Day 7

## Prague

This morning, drive to Terezin (Theresienstadt) for a **guided visit of this World War II concentration camp** and Jewish ghetto located outside Prague. This former garrison town was built at the end of the 18th century by Emperor Joseph II as an ingenious system of military fortresses. However, when the Nazis took control of the Czech Republic during World War II, they converted the whole area into a concentration camp and Jewish ghetto. The afternoon is at leisure, time for individual sightseeing or last minute souvenir shopping. Dinner and overnight in Prague.

## Day 8

## Departure

Following breakfast this morning check out of your hotel and depart for the airport for your flight home.

**End of arrangements**

*Note: unexpected circumstances may cause changes to the order of events outlined in the itinerary.*

### Transportation

If there is time, the group will be briefed about the region by their tour escort. Please note that tour escorts are not licensed guides and are not permitted by law to give any sort of sightseeing tours. If you would like a guide for any of these locations, we would be happy to advise the additional costs and make the appropriate arrangements.
- Music stands, risers, keyboards, chairs etc may require an additional charge if requested.
- TQI reserves the right to make alterations necessary due to lack of participation in any custom tour program or festival. Cost will fluctuate when your group size increases or decrease primarily due to transportation utilization.
