Madrid

Day 1 **Flight** Board your overnight flight to Madrid. Meals on the plane. Madrid Day 2 AM Arrive at Madrid airport and meet your tour manager after customs. Transfer to the center. Madrid is the capital of Spain and home of the Royal Family. Madrid, from the Moorish name Majrit, began as an obscure fort which formed part of the outlying defense for the magnificent Moorish city of Toledo. One of the few major capitals of the world not situated at some natural crossroads of transportation or commerce, Madrid was deliberately chosen as the capital of an emerging Spain during the reconquest because of relative obscurity and the protection this afforded each of the rival feudal lords who contested for power in Spain. PM A local guide will show you all the highlights of Spain's capital during a Madrid city tour. See the Plaza España, the statue of Cervantes, the Royal Palace and the Puerta de Alcala and more. Check in to your hotel. FVF Dinner and overnight in Madrid. Day 3 Madrid AM Morning visit of the world-renowned Prado Museum, where you can see Spanish paintings from the 12th - 19th century. The Prado is indisputably the world's greatest collection of Spanish paintings. In addition, there are hundreds of famous foreign works, most of them having been bought of commissioned by Spain's art-loving kings. PM Possible performance for example at at Civic Hall, one of the many churches in Madrid or concert in cooperation with the American Club of Madrid. Or if weather permitting in the Music pavilion of Retiro Park, very suitable for informal concerts. EVE Dinner and overnight in Madrid.

<u>Day 4</u> <u>Madrid – Segovia – El Escorial</u>

- AM Today enjoy a full day excursion to Segovia and El Escorial. You will start with a visit of Segovia. During a **walking tour of the old city** you will see the cathedral, the famous ancient Roman aqueduct, the Alcázar and many other sights. The old city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site, and is surrounded by walls built in the 8th century AD, probably on a Roman base, and rebuilt extensively during the 15th century.
- PM After lunch board coach and transfer to El Escorial. Upon arrival visit the **Monastery of Escorial**, built by order of King Phillip II. The whole Escorial complex is composed of: The Basilica, The Palace of the Bourbons, The Palace of the Austrias, The Pantheons, The Museums, The Library and the Casitas. After the Escorial visit you will go to the Valley of the fallen, a memorial

monument of those who died during the Spanish Civil War. You will see the large cross and the impressive church excaved in the rock, larger than the St Peter's Basilica in Rome. Return to Madrid afterwards.

EVE Dinner and overnight in Madrid.

Day 5 Madrid

AM Morning choice of visit:

- 1) Royal Palace: the official residence of His Majesty The King of Spain. During a guided tour you will see many rooms, as well as the Real Basilica de San Francisco el Grande. The vast palace is richly decorated by artists such as Velázquez and Goya. Several royal collections of great historical importance are kept at the palace, including the Royal Armoury and weapons dating back to the 13th century, and the world's only complete Stradivarius string quintet.
- 2) **Bernabeu**, the Madrid soccer stadium of Real Madrid: Enjoy a guided city of the "home stadium of the most successful soccer club in the world (most titles won).
- PM Possible performance for example at the British Council School.
- EVE Farewell dinner and overnight in Madrid.

Day 6 Departure

AM Following breakfast this morning transfer to the airport for your flight home
